WARM UP QUESTION: Have you ever met a famous person? Were you impressed or disappointed?

READ: Mark 1:1 - 2:12

FOCUS: Jesus Christ is the Gospel. Not only does He bring us good news, He *is* the good news!

OBSERVE:

- Jesus Christ is the Gospel. He is the Messiah and the Son of God.
- The good news is that there is One worthy of reverence, who triumphs over the enemy, whom we can follow, whose relationship with the Father guides his life, who delivers, who restores, who heals and forgives.
- We need to build a relationship with Jesus Christ.

REFLECT:

- Do you understand the Gospel with your mind? Have you read and digested what the Scriptures say?
- Have you had ongoing encounters with Jesus where He has saved you from your sins, healed your body, freed you from your past, and shown you how to serve Him?

TAKE ACTION:

- Develop a loving relationship with Jesus, by repenting each time He shows you something in your life that is less than His best, and believing that He is the solution to your sinful nature.
- Share with your community what your challenges are in walking out your Christian life.
- Ask God to show you your mission in His Kingdom.

PRAY:

Lord Jesus, you came to walk among us in the person of a man so that we might know You, the embodiment of the good news. We ask You for forgiveness, healing, and restoration in our daily lives.

Help deepen our connection with You, even as You did in Your relationship with Your Heavenly Father. Show us our purpose and direction in Your Kingdom and help us walk it out day by day. Amen
