WARM UP QUESTION: What is not negotiable to you?

READ: Isaiah 9:6-7 (KJV)

FOCUS: The rule of King Jesus brings peace into our lives.

OBSERVE:

Christ the King came to bring peace on earth, but not in the way we often imagine. The answer to peace in this world starts with peace with God.

The Lord's favor rests on those who He is pleased with. Because we have been reconciled to the Father, we have peace. The enemy's power is broken in Christ Jesus, the Prince of Peace.

DISCUSS:

1. What did the Holy Spirit bring to your attention as you listened to the sermon and/or studied this sermon discussion guide?
2. We have peace with God when we put our faith in what Christ accomplished on the cross - taking our place, paying the penalty for our sins. Because of that, God's wrath is no longer on us.
3. When we have peace with God, we can then experience peace within ourselves and ultimately, peace with others. What is "peace of mind"?

TAKE ACTION: Allow/let Jesus become the King of your life. How do you think you could experience peace, the state of wholeness?

Help others to acquire peace by inviting them to Christ and discipling them.

PRAY: *Holy Father, we thank You for being King of our lives. Thank You for extending Your gift of peace to us. Your peace is different from that which the world offers. Thank You for Your sacrificial death on the cross. We ask You to help us keep our trust and confidence in You and what You did at Calvary. We ask these petitions in Jesus' name, Amen.*
