WARM UP QUESTION: Have you ever wanted to change someone's life for the better but didn't have the means? What were you lacking?

READ: I Corinthians 12-14

FOCUS: The Holy Spirit gives gifts to us for others, so that they can know God.

OBSERVE:

- The gifts of the Holy Spirit come from God. They are given by grace and are not awards, badges of maturity or signs of good behavior. They are gifts.
- There are manifestation gifts such as prophecy, ministry gifts such as evangelism,\ and motivational gifts such as helping and serving. Additional gifts are craftsmanship, hospitality, intercession, missionary and music.
- The gifts are given to us to benefit others, so that people might see, hear and know God.
- We should eagerly desire spiritual gifts.

DISCUSS:

- As you study this, what is the Holy Spirit bringing to your attention?
- Have you noticed the gifts of the Spirit in action as you've progressed on your spiritual walk? How did this affect you?
- Have you ever desired to help someone else in a supernatural way but weren't able to?

TAKE ACTION:

- Tell each person in your group which gifts you see active in their life. Pray for opportunities to develop these gifts in the safe space of your group.
