WARM UP QUESTION: What do you do with the information you read in books?

READ: 2 Kings 6:15-17 (ESV)

FOCUS: Spiritual blindness costs us more than we think, but seeing clearly changes everything.

OBSERVE:

- Elisha had faith and was not troubled by the enemy's plans. He said, "Those who are with us outnumber those who are with them." When our lives are in the proper alignment with God, the enemy who opposes us is always outnumbered.
- God is our Protector. God always moves on our behalf to block the enemy's plan to destroy or take advantage of us.
- The King of Aramean attempted to capture Elisha.

DISCUSS:

1. How does God protect us? What role does God play in our lives?
2. Why do we need The Holy Spirit to lead us in various situations?
3. How does spiritual blindness negatively affect us?

TAKE ACTION:

- Listen to God's advice and promptings when dealing with others and/or facing calamities. Learn to pray and meditate to follow His voice.
- Can you remember a time when God protected you from something you deemed difficult? Explain.
- How does the spiritual realm and the natural realm differ?

PRAY: Holy Father, help us to surrender to You and trust You to lead us when we face spiritual opposition. Open our eyes to see what is truly Your will and to walk faithfully in You. We ask these petitions in Jesus' name, Amen.
