**WARM UP QUESTION:** Have you ever failed a class or been denied a reward based on a technicality, or the opposite: has a teacher ever accepted an assignment that was late?

**READ:** Romans 11:25-29

**FOCUS:** Although we stumble, God's grace and mercy are abundantly available through Jesus.

**OBSERVE:**

- At the time Jesus lived, many of the Jews rejected him. Although the early Church began with Jewish believers, it soon grew to include more Gentile believers than Jewish believers.
- From the point of view of Gentile Christians, how should we see the place of the Jewish people in the Kingdom of God?
- God's plan for the Jews is irrevocable, but by their stumbling grace has been extended to us. We now have access to salvation and are received into the Kingdom of God.

**DISCUSS:**

- What stood out to you, or what did the Holy Spirit bring to your attention?
- What life experiences, memories, thoughts, or emotions did this bring up for you?
- Does this chapter change your point of view on the place Jews have in the Kingdom of God?

**TAKE ACTION:**

- Have you had opportunities to know any Jews, either "secular" or those who followed the God of Abraham and Moses as closely as we follow his Son?
- In your group, talk about how you can get to know Jews and how they follow their faith, while letting the grace of God and your love for Jesus shine through you in a non-confrontational manner.

**PRAY:** *Almighty God, thank you for your chosen people, the Children of Israel. Thank you for allowing us who are outside that family tree to be grafted into your Kingdom by extending grace through your Son Jesus to all who would believe. Bring in the full harvest! We look forward to your reigning forever on earth. In Jesus' name, we pray. Amen!*
