WARM UP QUESTION: When was the last time you discovered something new or helpful for a problem you needed to solve?

READ: I Corinthians 2:12-13

FOCUS: The Holy Spirit freely gives us what the world cannot.

OBSERVE:

- Relying on the wisdom of the world instead of God's wisdom makes us vulnerable to influences of the wrong spiritual forces.
- The Holy Spirit is holy and is a part of the triune God. He appeals to our hearts about our sins and convicts us of our need for Jesus. The Holy Spirit can abide in us if we confess our sins, accept Jesus as Lord and enter into a relationship with God.
- The Holy Spirit works in us through a process called sanctification. We can learn how to be and live like Jesus as we listen and obey the guidance of the Word and Spirit.
- To learn from the Holy Spirit, we must lean into the elements of F.A.I.T.H.

DISCUSS:

- What did the Holy Spirit bring to your attention during this sermon?
- What does it mean to be under the influence of the worldly spirits versus the Holy Spirit? Can you share any of your life experiences?
- How do you sense the Holy Spirit is guiding you to respond to this?

TAKE ACTION:

- Do you feel burdened or overcome by the influence of worldly spirits? Consider receiving prayer from the Prayer Team or connecting with your life group leader.
