WARM UP QUESTION: Can you remember the last time you felt disappointed in a friend or family member because they failed to keep a promise made to you?

READ: Romans 3:1-20

FOCUS: God's faithfulness saves us from faithlessness.

OBSERVE:

- Faithfulness is lasting loyalty and trustworthiness in a relationship. God embodies faithfulness in His relationship with us, even when we are not loyal or trustworthy ourselves. He always keeps His promises.
- From the beginning, God chose the Jewish nation to be His special people. Even when they were not loyal and turned to other gods, He remained faithful (Deuteronomy 7:6)
- God had promised a long time ago to send Jesus to die for our sins and redeem us.
 Romans 5:8 says God demonstrates His love for us in that while we were yet sinners
 Christ died for us. He kept His promise.
- Now God's faithfulness extends beyond the Jews to include non-Jews. In spite of our evil ways and disobedience, God extends His love and forgiveness to us.

DISCUSS:

- What stood out to you or what did the Holy Spirit bring to your attention from this study?
- Does this bring up any memories, thoughts, or emotions from your life?
- Do you sense the Holy Spirit is calling you to a life of renewed faithfulness to God? What is He saying?

TAKE ACTION:

- Decide today to faithfully participate in a group or class you've committed to and have failed to attend. Make arrangements to be a part of it today.
- Ask others in your group which of your attitudes or actions might need to change.

PRAY: Lord, there is no one like You. You are holy and faithful through the ages. I am so grateful for your love and faithfulness to me. Please teach me Lord how to be faithful like you are in Jesus's name!
