**WARM UP QUESTION:** What was the hardest rule to follow as a child?

**READ:** Leviticus 19:1-2

**FOCUS:** God desires a people who reflect His nature/character so that they can enjoy His presence and all the blessings that come from being His covenant people.

**OBSERVE:**

- In Leviticus, God gave the Israelites a set of rules to live a life that is honorable to the Lord. These rules focus on purity through rituals and morality. Living by these rules enabled them to meet with God in His holy space.
- We are now able to enter the Holy place through Jesus Christ, our great High Priest. We have a new heart and spirit through His sacrifice; we are no longer bound to purity rituals.

**DISCUSS:**

- What stood out to you, or what did the Holy Spirit bring to your attention?
- What life experiences, memories, thoughts, or emotions did this bring up for you when you reflect on times you have seen God's holiness?
- How do you sense the Holy Spirit is guiding you to respond to God's desire for you to come near him?

**TAKE ACTION:**

- In your group, share about a time you experienced God's protection, as well as what that experience made you understand about His nature.
- Does your life reflect God's nature and character? Spend time in the Word and prayer today and ask God to guide you closer towards him. Join a discipleship class to grow more in your walk with God.
