WARM UP QUESTION: When you thank God for meals, do you ever thank Him for clean water?

READ: Jeremiah 29:11 -14

FOCUS: The future is ours.

OBSERVE:

- God has plans to give His people a future and a hope. This includes those in other parts of the world who are persecuted by unfriendly societies or who have never even heard of Him at all.
- Philippians 2:12-13 tells us that He gives us both the desire and the strength to do His good pleasure. We know that part of His good pleasure is that we carry His kingdom to these persecuted and unreached people.
- As we walk out our lives in God, we should keep His Word at the forefront of our motivation and plans. In Genesis 8:22, He promises us that this approach will bring us good success.

DISCUSS:

- What stood out to you or what did the Holy Spirit bring to your attention from this study?
- When you think about your hopes and your future, do any of your memories, thoughts or emotions come to mind?
- Do you sense the Holy Spirit calling you to reach people under persecution or who have never heard the Gospel at all? Beyond supporting missionary groups financially, is He calling you to go or do anything in particular?

TAKE ACTION:

- Discuss the ways God has called you to “go therefore and make disciples of all nations.”

PRAY: *Lord Jesus, You instructed us to go and make disciples of all nations. Give us the will and the strength to carry out this command. We pray this in Your Name, Amen.*
