WARM UP QUESTION: If you knew you were going on a very long trip, what instructions or advice would you give to the most important people in your life before departing?

READ: Matthew 28:16-20; Acts 1: 3-12 (ESV)

FOCUS: According to Jesus, we were meant to make disciples.

OBSERVE:

- The Great Commission is to spread the teachings of Jesus to all nations, to make disciples, to baptize them, and to teach them to observe and do all He commanded.
- All authority in heaven and on earth was given to Jesus by the Father. We are authorized to tell and live the truth. The Holy Spirit empowers us to be effective witnesses of his truth through our actions, words, and/or deeds.

DISCUSS:

- What stood out to you as you listened to the sermon and/or you discussed this study guide? Are you willing to share your thoughts with others?
- What did Jesus empower His followers to do and are you able to do it? How do you know you are able to complete this task? Do you believe the Lord desires us to teach others?
- What are disciples of Jesus charged to do? What is your mission? What do you believe is the purpose or reason for your life?

TAKE ACTION:

- Spread the gospel to others. Teach them how to obey God's Word and to follow Him.
- Devote yourself to the apostles' teachings and to fellowship. Follow-up with others by using the One to One method or by sharing in Life Groups as you walk the King's Park Discipleship Path. Testify to your values or beliefs by living God's way before others.
