WARM UP QUESTION: Have you ever ignored your GPS and ended up more lost than before? What does that experience reveal about our tendency to trust our own direction over guidance we've been given?

READ: 1 Corinthians 15:8-10; Acts 26:9-18

FOCUS: Jesus repositions us for lasting significance through his grace and our humility.

OBSERVE:

- Paul's problem is our problem—a cycle of pride and insecurity that keeps us self-focused, strains our relationships, and pulls us away from our purpose. We try to arrive at God's destination without relying on God's grace.
- God's Positioning System is his Grace Powerfully Shifting us. Grace comes to us, convicts us, and commissions us—rerouting our lives from self-made righteousness to Christ-centered identity.
- Humility is the position that allows us to fully receive and walk in God's grace. Pride is healed by dependence on God; insecurity is healed by identity in Christ.

DISCUSS:

- What stood out to you as you listened to the sermon and/or discussed this study guide? Are you willing to share your thoughts with others?
- Where do you tend to look for your value or worth—appearance, accomplishments, position, resources? How has that fueled either pride or insecurity in your life?
- In what area is God currently "goading" you or whispering conviction? What would it look like to make a U-turn and follow his direction?
- How does seeing Jesus as the source of your salvation and worth change the way you approach success and failure?

TAKE ACTION:

- Humble yourself before God this week by asking Paul's question: "Who are you, Lord?" Invite him to redefine your identity and direct your steps.
- Identify one area of pride or insecurity and surrender it to Jesus. Trust his grace rather than your performance.
- Respond to the conviction of the Holy Spirit by making a specific U-turn—a relationship to strengthen, a habit to change, a step of obedience to take.

PRAY: *Lord, thank you for your grace that meets us, convicts us, and commissions us. Forgive us for the pride and insecurity that pull us away from you. Teach us to humble ourselves, to find our identity in Christ alone, and to trust your positioning system to lead us into everything you have for our lives. In Jesus' name we pray, amen.*
