

Sermon Discussion Guide - Hope of Future Glory (Romans 2.8) 11/02/2025 | Pastor Reggie Roberson

WARM UP QUESTION: What is something you cannot do without?

READ: Romans 8:18 (NIV)

FOCUS: New life in Christ is a life anchored in the hope of future glory. OBSERVE:

- We all need hope. The reward for being children of God is nothing less than the glory of God. We cannot afford to lose sight of that vision. We must have hope for what's ahead.
- We share in His sufferings before sharing in His glory.
- Our decisions should position us for the glory God has planned for us later. We cannot afford to lose focus on the eternal things of the Sovereign God.

DISCUSS:

- 1. What did the Holy Spirit bring to your attention as you listened to the sermon and/or studied this sermon discussion guide?
- 2. How did sin enter the world and what was the result of that happening? Do you believe a day is coming when you will no longer battle sin or weakness?
- 3. What does Romans 8:28 mean to you? Do you believe this promise is for everyone who has been made righteous by faith in Christ and is led by the Holy Spirit? Is this promise for you?

TAKE ACTION:

- As you listened to the sermon and as you studied/discussed this guide, what moment resurfaced in your mind when you knew you had to rely on The Holy Spirit to bring hope to that present situation?
- Fix your eyes on Jesus and the things that are eternal since what is seen is temporary. Do you believe you will share in the glory of God? What is the golden chain of salvation and how does it apply to you?

PRAY: Holy Father, we thank you for being who you are in our lives. We repent for every moment we lose faith or confidence in your overcoming power. Please help us to remain focused on you and what is eternal as we walk in humility and demonstrate we love you and others. Thank you for the glory that awaits us.
