WARM UP QUESTION: Have you been a member of a club? What were the requirements for joining the club, and what sorts of privileges did you have as a member?

READ: Romans 8:31-39

FOCUS: God is for us because he loves us, and nothing will ever change that.

OBSERVE:

- Earlier in the chapter, Paul describes how we have new life in the Spirit, justification through Jesus' death and resurrection, adoption as sons and daughters, and his glorification in our lives.
- When we meet opposition, we can walk in assurance of God's provision for us. No opposition in this world can come against us if God is for us.
- When we meet accusations, we can accept His justification "just-as-if-l-had-never."
- When we meet condemnation, we can receive his redemption. Nothing can separate us from the love of Christ.

DISCUSS:

- What stood out to you, or what did the Holy Spirit bring to your attention?
- Recall a time when you really needed to know the love of God. How did that play out?
- How is the Spirit prompting you to respond to opposition, accusation and condemnation?

TAKE ACTION:

- Share times you have met spiritual opposition, accusation or condemnation. Discuss ways to navigate these situations at times when you are alone.
- Remind each other what the "just-as-if-l-had-never" provision of Christ's work on our behalf really represents.
- Discuss how you can come alongside, to navigate opposition, accusation and condemnation together as brothers and sisters.

PRAY: Lord Jesus, thank you for your redemptive work on our behalf. Teach us stand on the saving work you have done and the promises you have made to us so we can resist any opposition, accusation or condemnation that comes our way. Help us rejoice in worship and remember your faithfulness. In Jesus' name, Amen!
