**WARM UP QUESTION:** What is the most precious gift you have received? What did you do to ensure you used it well?

READ: 1 Corinthians 4:1-5

**FOCUS:** King Jesus calls us to be stewards of His treasure.

## **OBSERVE:**

- Paul says that we are stewards of the "mysteries of God," the revealed Gospel of Jesus Christ. We are entrusted with both its preservation and its proclamation. We care for God's people by discipling them in these truths, and we share this life-changing message with those who don't yet know Him.
- Two key characteristics define a true steward: servanthood and faithfulness. As servants, we work under the authority of Jesus to glorify God within His Church. We are faithful when God can count on us to keep believing in, and serving Him.
- We live out our calling as stewards by living in unity with other believers, pursuing purity
  and integrity in our personal lives, showing charity by serving the Church in love, living in
  clarity of the reality of the resurrection, and practicing generosity.

## **DISCUSS:**

- What stood out to you, or what did the Holy Spirit bring to your attention?
- In what ways do you feel you have not been a good steward of what God has entrusted to you?
- Is there anything God has been asking you to do that you haven't yet done?

## TAKE ACTION:

- If you haven't yet done so, join Growth Track to discover how you can use your gifts to serve the church and show the love of Christ.
- In your LIFE Group, discuss the five ways through which believers live out their callings as stewards—unity, purity, charity, clarity and generosity—and share the area in which you feel the Spirit prompting you to act?
