**WARM-UP QUESTION:** What does Mother's Day look like for you this year?

**READ:** Ephesians 2:10

**FOCUS:** God is the designer who has a master design plan for us, our roles and our families. His design is masterful.

**OBSERVE:**

God's Divine Design Principles:

- Variety
  - God created everything for a reason and with distinct variety.
  - God designed us in such a unique way, He doesn't want us to compare ourselves to others, even when it is tempting.
  - God loves variety, but there is also order. Order creates security and boundaries, and the Word of God is our design manual.
  
- Renovation
  - Divine design usually requires seasons of renovation. Everyone needs renovation at some point in their lives because we all mess up.
  - There is grace for every season of renovation (2 Corinthians 12:7-10). Let's lean into His grace and let Him grow us in ways we never expected.
  
- Community
  - We are made for each other!
  - We are part of a family.
  - Miracles happen when we live in community.

**REFLECT:**

- How are you following the Divine Design God created for you?
- Why is it hard for you to accept the design of God in this season of life?
- Do you feel that you need renovation? If so, are you willing to ask God for His grace to cover your situation?

**TAKE ACTION:**
