

ONE2ONE

WHAT IS THE ONE2ONE?

 The One2One is a personal discipleship guide that helps people understand what it means to follow Jesus and to help others to follow Jesus.

OBJECTIVES OF THE ONE2ONE

- Engage people with the truths of Gospel and the Word of God.
- Establish people in the fundamentals of following Jesus and in the community of Jesus.
- Equip people to use this tool to disciple others.

HOW TO USE THE TOOL

- · Have them read
- Ask questions
 E.g. "What stood out to you?"

Share

Avoid "Christianese"

ACTIVATION: Engage

ACTIVATION: Establish

Tip: Model vulnerability and personal

application of the Gospel

ACTIVATION: Equip

Tip: The goal is asking good questions and listening rather than teaching

FAQS

Should follow-up begin only after someone has received Christ as Lord and Savior?

- One2One is designed to be used with anyone who is open to ministry, no matter if they have
 prayed to receive Christ or not. If someone is open to the gospel and is willing to meet with you,
 then start with the first chapter, "A New Start: Salvation" and continue chapter by chapter as long
 as they will meet with you.
- If someone has just prayed the sinner's prayer in the service or in an evangelistic event, you can share "Getting Started."

Who is qualified to do personal follow-up?

• Every Christian should be involved in personal evangelism, follow-up and discipleship. As soon as a new Christian has been through One2One booklet, s/he should be able to share it with others.

How often should I meet with the person I'm following up or discipling?

One2One can be used seven days in a row or one lesson each week for seven weeks. It all
depends on your schedule and the availability of the new disciple. The first follow-up meeting
should be as soon as possible after a person surrenders his/her life to Christ. We should follow
up with the new believer before the devil tries to steal the Word that was sown in his/her heart
(Mark 4:15).

Does personal follow-up and discipleship always have to be one-on-one?

No. Personal follow-up and discipleship can be effectively done in small groups, but it must be
personal. You can even have another disciple that you are training observe and assist you as you
follow up with a new believer. The relationship that is being built is as important as the material
being covered.

Should I go over the "Personal Application" section each time?

 Absolutely. While it may only take fifteen minutes to read through the chapter and make a few comments, the application questions may take from five to fifteen minutes. This is where you can evaluate the progress of your disciples and offer specific and practical help where they need it most.

Is this the only way we disciple others?

The One2One is just one of the discipleship tools that we use in our discipleship path. It is not
meant to be the only way to disciple others. It is meant to be a discipleship tool to begin the
discipleship process, however, discipleship does not end when the One2One is finished.

Which version of the One2One app should I use?

• We use the ESV version because it has seven sessions that end with the topic discipleship and corresponds with our children's seven sessions for the One2One as well.
