WARM UP QUESTIONS:

1 Corinthians 11:1

“Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ.” (ESV)

“Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ.” (NIV)

Our topic today is about a culture of making disciples.

- Discipleship is about following Christ.
- Discipleship is also about following Christ with others who are following Christ.
- Discipleship includes helping others know God so that they can follow Christ.

Our hope is that we can create a strong culture of discipleship.

NOTES

WHAT IS “CULTURE?”

- The application of labor or other means to improve good qualities in, or growth; as the culture of the mind; the culture of virtue (Noah Webster, 1828).
- The set of shared attitudes, values, goals, and practices that characterizes an institution or organization (Merriam Webster).

Culture creation requires work; it requires a group of people having a shared value practiced over time; it also needs to be transferrable to the next generation; Culture can be imparted (heart to heart) and can be experienced (felt, seen and heard).

BY GOD’S GRACE, WE CAN FOCUS ON DOING ONE THING FOR A LONG TIME.

Matthew 28:18-20

And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

Ephesians 2:8-9 (NIV)

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— 9 not by works, so that no one can boast.

It is by God’s grace that we were saved; by grace that we came to know God; by grace that we can grow together; by grace that we can discover God’s purpose; by grace that we make a difference!

2. WE

Acts 2:42-47

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. 43 Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. 44 All the believers were together and had everything in common. 45 They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. 46 Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, 47 praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

"We" means being in a community; sharing our lives with each other and not just doing a set of tasks Sunday in and Sunday out; it means getting to know each other, praying for one another and serving and caring for one another.

APPLICATION:
