MARK 14:3-9

Heavenly Father, thank You for loving us through Your Son's life. Lord Jesus, we remember Your boldness in facing Your death. Thank You also for conquering sin and death for us that we might have a new life. May we spend our earthly time, treasures and talents to worship You extravagantly. Give us an undivided heart and teach us to be devoted to You only. We repent of doubt, apathy and unbelief. Give us courage so that we might eagerly preach the gospel to all creation (Pause: Let us name our unsaved relatives and friends and let's pray for them to be saved). These we ask in Jesus' Name, Amen.

Mark 14:10-11; 17-21; Mark 14:26-31; Mark 14:43-50; 66-72

Heavenly Father, we humble ourselves before You. We acknowledge our own weaknesses and failures. We are no better than Your disciples who betrayed, denied and abandoned You in Your most sorrowful moments. We repent of the times that we too lacked faith, doubted You and denied You by our own words and deeds or by the lack of them (Pause: Let us confess any sin; ask and receive forgiveness again). Create in us a pure heart and renew a steadfast spirit in us. Help us overcome our unbelief; increase our faith. Revive us, in the name of Jesus, Amen.

Mark 14:12-16; Mark 14:22-25

Lord Jesus, we want to thank You for Your sacrifice on the cross. We remember that Your body was broken so that a new and living way may be opened for us to be a part of Your family. We also want to thank You for Your blood that was shed for our forgiveness and cleansing (Pause: Let us ask God to show us anyone we might need to forgive; let us be freed of any unforgiveness, resentment and bitterness and speak blessing over them). Lord, in Your name, we are also believing for healing and wholeness because You said that by Your wounds we are healed (Pause: Receive health and healing). Thank You, Jesus, Amen.

Mark 15:21-32

We remember and we are grateful (Let's pause to thank the Lord in our words/language). You bore the curse of the law so that we can be free and now live in the blessing promised to Abraham. Bless us indeed and enlarge our territory; let Your hand be with us and keep us from harm so that it would not bring us pain. In Christ, we are blessed with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realms (Pause: Let's briefly claim specific blessings from the Lord). These we claim in Jesus, Amen.

Mark 15:33-47

Heavenly Father, thank You for sending Your Son to die for all of humanity. Lord Jesus, we believe that You died the death we should have died so that we who live might no longer live for ourselves but for You, who was raised to life forever. Holy Spirit, Giver of Life, fill us again with the power of this new life. Revive us; revive our families and our country; Also, bring about revival in the nations of the world. Your love compels us to make You known through missions and church planting, so that we might bring about worship for Your Name where there is none (Pause: Let's pray for specific nations, people groups or countries that the Lord has put in your heart to pray for). These we ask, in Jesus' Name, Amen.
